This hands-on workshop is designed to increase your knowledge and confidence in using watercolour as a medium to create different painting effects. It incorporates many of the advanced technical skills which Jo recently acquired at a one week atelier in France. It will also focus on what not to do, as well as what to do well.

The workshop will explore:

- how to distinguish and use different types of watercolour paints and when to use transparent and opaque paints;
- wet and dry brush painting techniques;
- blending and layering paints and using washes to further enhance the art work;
- colour mixing, use of warm and cool colours;
- how and when to use hard and soft edges;
- maintaining a vibrancy in your art work so that it is rich and clean;
- using light sources to further enrich and heighten interest in your work.

The workshop is based on a step by step guide to layering and creating an art piece as illustrated.

Please bring:

- Watercolour paper preferably hot press (smooth)
- A selection of brushes 000 to 1 including a fairly hard flat brush. I find taklon synthetic brushes work well.
