Materials:

- 1 Sheet of Arches 300 gsm Rough Paper Cold Press
- 2B Pencil
- Kneadable eraser
- Water Jar - provided at DAS
- Tissues or a roll of Toilet Paper
- Board to work on
- Tape
- Watercolour Paints – Lemon Yellow, Raw Sienna, Cad Red, Lavendar, Burnt Sienna, Cobalt Blue and Raw Umber. Please feel free to bring any other colours.
- Smallish Brushes but not too small apart from maybe one for the finer details.



The workshop will focus firstly on how to draw a portrait with the correct dimensions giving the subject weight. We will then approach the painting, starting with flesh-coloured washes, leaving the all-important highlights. Lastly, we will add detail.

Cass has lived in Western Australia for the last 30 odd years, enjoying the pursuit of her career as an artist. She's an avid watercolourist and takes great delight in the spontaneity and elusiveness of the medium. She has taught at the Tresillian Art Centre in Nedlands and previous to that taught at the Claremont School of Art and the Ocean Ridge Community Centre.
